Please plan to keep the following items with you when you move.

- Address Books

- Certificates of Deposit, Stocks & Bonds
- Collections (Coins, Stamps, etc.)
- Computers, Laptops & Tablets
- Heirlooms and other irreplaceable items
- Immunization Records for your family and your pets
- Jewelry
- Keys
- Medications & Prescriptions
- Passports
- Perishable Items
- Personal Legal Documents (Deeds, Certificates of Title, Insurance Policies, Licenses, Wills, etc.)
- Pets
- Plants
- Precious Metals (Gold, Silver, etc.)
- Storage Devices (CDs, DVDs, Thumb Drives & External Hard Drives)

This list is not exhaustive. You may have other items that have special sentimental or extraordinary value that you will want to keep in your possession during the move.
